Indian Institute of Management Ranchi, the ninth member of the prestigious Indian Institutes of Management family, was established on December 15, 2009, under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, under the aegis of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India with the extensive support of the Government of Jharkhand. The Institute has been accorded the status of 'Institute of National Importance' by the introduction of the IIM Act 2017.

The 11th Annual Convocation of IIM Ranchi for the batch of 2020-22 was held on Saturday, 22 April 2023, at Swami Vivekanand Auditorium, IIM Ranchi, Prabandhan Nagar, Nayasarai Road, Ranchi. This was the first ever convocation held full-scale in its own permanent campus.

Shri C P Radhakrishnan, Hon'ble Governor of Jharkhand, graced the occasion as the Chief Guest and delivered the convocation address. Shri Anand Kripalu, MD and Global CEO of Blackstone – EPL Ltd., was the Guest of Honour.
