IIM RANCHI WILL CONDUCT A STUDY TO ANALYSE THE THEMES AND ISSUES ADDRESSED IN 100 EPISODES OF 'MANN KI BAAT'

Honourable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has the 'Mann ki Baat' initiative to share thoughts and opinions on various social, economic, and political issues. The first episode was broadcast on 3rd October 2014 on the occasion of Vijay Dashami. Since then, it has been broadcast on the last Sunday of every month in various languages across the country. The programme is broadcasted on Doordarshan, All India Radio, and other platforms, including social media.

'Mann ki Baat' aims to encourage people to share their views, ideas, and opinions on different issues that affect the people.
