

Academics hail Nat'l Edu Policy on 3rd year of launch

Ranchi: Several academics have hailed the National Education Policy (NEP) which entered the third year of its launch on Tuesday.

Addressing a press conference at IIM-Ranchi, organised in collaboration with the directorate of regional development and entrepreneurship, Jharkhand and PIB, Ranchi, IIM director Deepak Kumar Srivastava spoke about the Integrated Program in Management (IPM), which aims to provide a multidisciplinary course that includes units aligned with the NEP.

Ranchi University vice-

chancellor Ajit Kumar Sinha emphasized the impact of NEP on the educational scenario and policies in the institute.

The experts said to promote flexibility of subjects, critical thinking and multidisciplinary learning, their institutes have introduced various elective courses like cinematography, water management, sports management, drama and theatre among others.
