

Indigenous film fest at IIM-Ranchi on Aug 26 & 27

Ranchi: A film festival, titled 'Samuday Ke Saaath — Indigenous Film Festival', would be organised by the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Ranchi in collaboration with TATA Steel Foundation at the IIM premises on August 26 and 27 to explore Jharkhand through tribal films.

IIM-Ranchi director Deepak Kumar Srivastava said the film festival would highlight the multi-faceted shades of the indigenous communities in Jharkhand and celebrate their uniqueness and resilience.

It would consist of screening of feature films, discussions, and story-telling. Day-1 would be on the theme, 'Cinema and Adivasiyat', and Day 2 on 'Tribal Heritage and Cultural Resilience'.

"IIM aims to harness the power of films to highlight the cultural identity and wisdom of the tribal communities. A cultural programme to highlight rich tribal history and heritage would also be held on the occasion," he stated.
