Global Conference 2023 from 26 to 29 December 2023.



RANCHI— December 25, 2023: Indian Institute of Management Ranchi announces its hosting of the 16th ISDSI Global Conference 2023. Scheduled to take place from 26th December 2023 to 29th December 2023 in the sprawling new campus of the institute, the conference will convene in a hybrid format, fostering a diverse global dialogue despite the challenges posed by the ongoing de-globalizing trends.

The ISDSI-Global Conference 2023 is set to become a pivotal platform for scholars, researchers, practitioners, and policymakers, providing an arena for sharing insights and ideas. The conference will culminate with discussions on Startup and Entrepreneurship, focusing on the Internationalization of Indian B-schools, and the valedictory address. An award ceremony will honour the exceptional contributions.
